Dear Friend

Some members of Sikh Union Coventry will be travelling to Nepal and Punjab during April this year to oversee our ongoing charity projects which are funded by your generous donations.

In Nepal, we shall visit the Baluwa Higher Secondary School which was severely damaged during the 2015 earthquake. Sikh Union along with The Northampton Punjabi Association were able to donate funds to the Nepalese Community of Nuneaton, who themselves raised considerable amount of funds to pay for the reconstruction. Further work is being carried out to parts of surrounding buildings, and we shall make a further donation of £1000.00 towards the total cost of approx. £3500.00

We shall also be making a donation to 120 younger school children for their books, pencils, pens etc.

Recently, we have also been made aware of the plight of a Sikh Community living in the area of Nepalganj in Sikhnpura village. There are approx. 7000 Sikhs in Nepal but the small community of Sikh families in Sikhnpura live in great poverty, and we, at Sikh Union have decided to help this community by raising funds by holding programmes on The Sikh Channel (Sky 829) starting on Friday 17th February 2017; and also by the help of Radio Panj (1521 AM) of Coventry starting on Monday 13th February at 10.00 am.

All funds raised will be used for any necessary work that is urgently needed for the improvement of living conditions. If you wish to make a donation, please see details below.

A pre-camp will be held for the measurement of limbs of disabled people who will be fitted with their appropriate prosthetics on the day of the Camp.

We will also visit Girls Ashrams in Delhi and Agra to provide funds for the ongoing improvements of living conditions.


